

# Study of Emotions for Children with ADHD

- We are looking for children who:
  - Have been diagnosed with ADD or ADHD *or*
  - Have not been tested for ADD/ADHD, but have problems paying attention, fidgeting, being hyperactive, or being easily distracted
- To participate, children must be between the ages of **7 to 11**

## Why should my child participate?

- This study examines emotions of children with ADD/ADHD. As a part of the study, children will receive a **free** evaluation for ADHD and **brief IQ and academic achievement tests**
  - **Results will be provided to parents *free of charge***

## What will I be asked to do?

- Parents and children will come to University of Louisville for a 2 sessions, including:
  - A 3 hour session where parents will complete questionnaires about the child's mood and behavior and the child will receive brief IQ and achievement testing
  - A 1 hour session where the child's heart rate will be monitored while they complete games and activities
  - Parents will keep track of the child's mood at home for 1 week.
- Parents and children will complete questionnaires at home 6 months and 1 year after these visits
- Families can receive up to **\$20** for participating.
