

Study of Emotions in Children

- We are looking for children between the ages of **7 to 11** and their parents to participate in a study of children's emotions

Why should my child participate?

- This study examines emotions of children. As a part of the study, children will receive a **free brief IQ and academic achievement test**
 - **Results will be provided to parents *free of charge***

What will I be asked to do?

- Parents and children will come to University of Louisville for a 2 sessions, including:
 - A 3 hour session where parents will complete questionnaires and answer questions about the child's mood and behavior and the child will receive brief IQ and achievement testing
 - A 1 hour session where the child's heart rate will be monitored while they complete games and activities
 - Parents will keep track of the child's mood at home for 1 week.
- Parents and children will complete questionnaires at home 6 months and 1 year after these visits
- Families can receive up to **\$20** for participating.
